I. **TIME COVERED:** 0900H-1700H, April 28-29 2025

II. **VENUE:** PESCADORES SUITES MOALBOAL

III. **MISSION:**

To educate and equip the community members and life guards of Moalboal in Basic life support, First Aid, Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR), Foreign body airway obstruction (FBAO) & Disaster Management training

IV. **CHRONOLOGICAL EVENTS:**

At 0900H on March 03, 2024, the 202nd Auxiliary Squadron and members of the Active Labangon Emergency Response Team arrived at Sampaguita function hall at Pescadores Suites Moalboal and began preparing the site for the day's activities. A prayer was led by LCDR Jhansien Malapit PCGA, followed by welcome remarks from AUX LCDR Nigel Psalm Yap PCGA. AUX CDR Percival Bolo PCGA provided a brief background of PCGA.

By 0930H, theories and discussions led by the team from Active Labangon Emergency Response Team, headed by James Patrick Leyson. Assisting from the team likewise are: Jaypee Davis, Jasper Eras, and Rhea Davis. Day one agenda was CPR, BLS, First Aid (bandaging skills and various kinds of carry) and day two concluded with FBAO, disaster management and actual hands-on scenarios of what was being taught of the skills during the workshop.

This initiative aimed to equip participants with essential life-saving knowledge and practical skills to confidently respond to medical emergencies—whether in the workplace, at home, or in the community. From **wound care** and **proper bandaging techniques** to **hands-only CPR** and **emergency response protocols**, every session was designed to promote safety, preparedness, and teamwork.

With this, the 202nd squadron together with **ALERT** remains committed to spreading awareness and building resilient communities through continuous training and education. Because when every second counts, being prepared makes all the difference!
